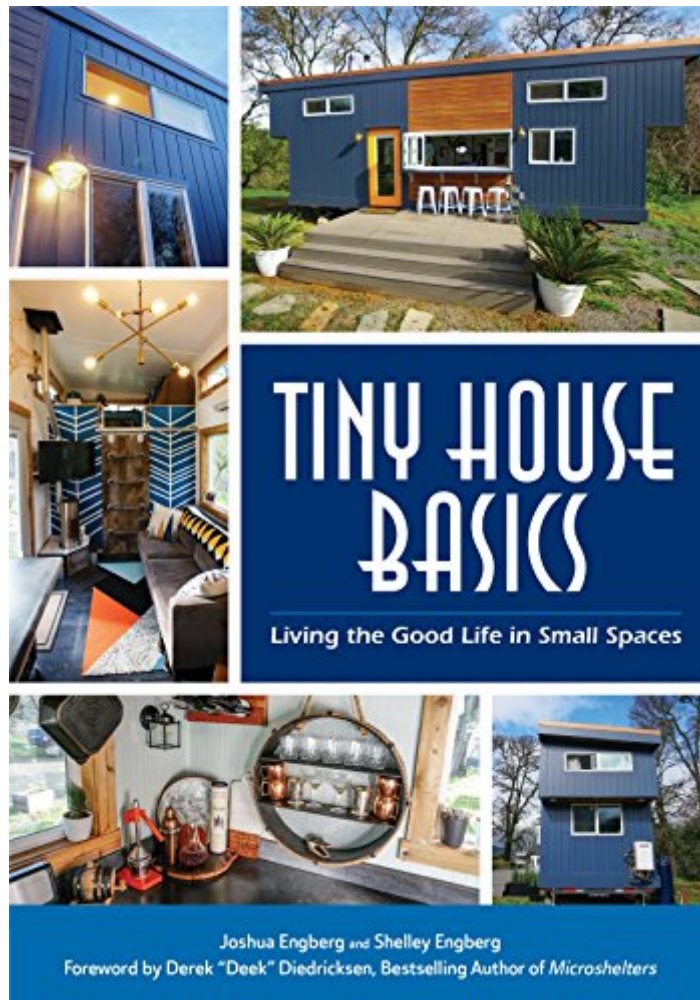

It has a lot of practical knowledge and tips for anyone that is considering to build or live tiny. This was a quick read. My favorite aspect was the close-up pictures of their home that I had not previously seen on social media, but had wondered about. Some of the tips were very helpful, as I'm currently in the dreaming/designing phase of tiny house ownership. The main reason I only gave 4 stars is because the book appears to have missed the proofreading stage, and there were MANY

typos, spelling, grammatical, and punctuation errors. This was quite distracting to me as I read. I also wish there was a little more detail on things like, what WAS the final cost of the build? And what kind of insulation did you choose? How much are your monthly utility expenditures? Even without these details, I still enjoyed reading this book. And I can always reach out to the authors via social media for more information. I would likely consult them for my tiny house project.

I'm actually disappointed in the book. While they did stick to talking about what they know, being their own experiences with building their tiny house and what all happened as a result, I felt like there were so many things they didn't address and that the book title was misleading. There were lots of typos, too. Overpriced for what it actually offers. If you're expecting to get a lot of knowledge around different options for your tiny house, this is NOT the book for you. This is only good for learning about their experience with the house shown and the pros and cons if you decide to build with HGTV. If you're planning your own home and need help deciding between options, you're better off consulting resources like Google and seeing what blogs + videos come up.

This is a cute book written by a cute couple with cute dogs about their cute little house. I initially read it because both my husband and I recently retired and bought a 24-foot Class C RV. I wanted to know how we can live/survive 2-3 weeks on the road (we are keeping our main home) with a cat. At this point, we are not yet ready to move into a tiny house as our main location. Still there were many good tips we can use for storage, relationships and traveling with a pet. My husband reminded me that with an awning and lawn chairs, we have a patio outside which will extend our space, even when it's raining. So that's one solution for cabin fever. The cons: the writing wasn't very professional and needed to be tightened up. The sentences and paragraphs were too long and there were punctuation errors. I'm surprised that the publisher's editor didn't do a better job with the editing. In the paperback version, the photos inside were only in black and white. But in a way, this was a clever plan on the authors' part. Readers can go to their Instagram feed to see the actual color photos--which are lovely-- and read their sales pitch for their trailer business. Very smart, Joshua and Shelley!
