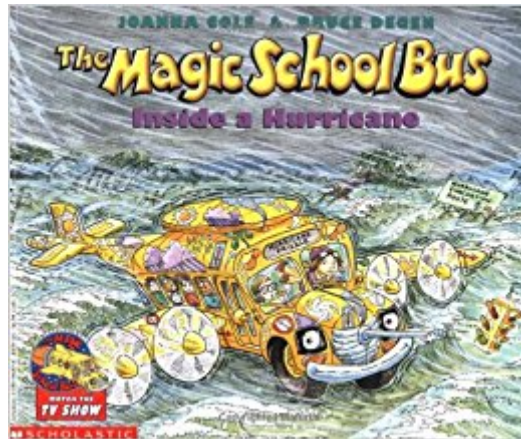

My four year old is a huge Magic School Bus fan. This book teaches children about all kinds of

weather phenomenon and concepts, including hurricanes, clouds, atmosphere, rain, etc. The pictures have a lot of detail. The text is presented in three ways -- through a main story that is complemented by comics-style dialogue, with more scientific information on the sidebars. You can adjust the way you read the book to include more or less text and information, which makes it suitable for a wider range of ages. This book is a great way to get kids curious and excited about learning about weather. I would recommend it for ages 4-8.
