

Synopsis

In 1994, Lizbeth Meredith said good-bye to her four- and six year-old daughters for a visit with their non-custodial father only to learn days later that they had been kidnapped and taken to their father's homecountry of Greece. This is an inspiring book about a woman who has been given little in the world -- she was regularly

abused and then abandoned by her mother at an early age. And so is cast out upon the sea of life unprepared. That what ensues is more of the same is not surprising, but when her implausibly (for me) mean, abusive husband abducts their young children and takes them to a foreign country, her deep, love-filled attachment for them propels her to acts that can only be described as heroic. Beautifully written, this is a heart-pounding thriller of a story that reads like a novel, but leaves you with insight and admiration for the astonishing capacity of the human spirit.

A story of a remarkable woman with the tenacity, perseverance and patience to recover, against extremely challenging odds, her two young daughters that had been stolen from their father. While this memoir exists because there are mean, selfish, unethical people in this world, Lizbeth describes the many generous people that went out of their way to help her. The book restores your faith in humanity: good overcomes evil but evil does leave a wake of destruction in the path. A must read for anyone in the situation of trying to recover kids stolen by a parent but an important read for those wanting a reminder of the the goodness of people and the importance of hope and never giving up your dreams.

I finished this book within 2 days, because I couldn't put it down! It was full of unbelievable legal drama & suspense mixed with humor and touching family connections. Lizbeth is a talented writer, making it a very easy read. As an advocate who works with women who experience domestic violence, this story exemplifies how the abuse doesn't necessarily end when the relationship ends. The horror that can occur after separation is very real and all too common. Lizbeth is incredibly strong, persistent, and patient. This plight to rescue her daughters is relatable and hard to imagine all at once. Lizbeth is an inspiration and hopefully this is just her first book!

A fine example of why I prefer non-fiction. Life is about decisions. Real decisions. Those we have to make and those we choose to make. And then there are the emotions that play into these decisions. No need to embellish, no need for contrived feelings in *Pieces of Me*. This is a real mother, in every sense of the word, who has lost her children. But love alone may not be enough to bring this mission to the hoped for conclusion. Meredith keeps you reading with your fingers crossed. This one kept me up late but was worth it.

Meredith's smooth and natural storytelling kept me right there with her in every moment of her

terrific book--be it facing her lying husband, breaking down from the horror of her situation, or being questioned by a judge in court. But readers will get more than just the heart-stopping story of her years long battle. She includes an especially interesting and helpful follow-up to her harrowing tale and its effect on her and her daughters. This is an important and gripping story!

This book and the woman who wrote it are amazing. I found myself wanting to binge read the entire volume. Lizbeth Meredith is not only a skilled and compelling writer, but someone who is willing to share herself as well as the intrigue and events which led to the kidnapping and ultimate rescue of her two daughters.
