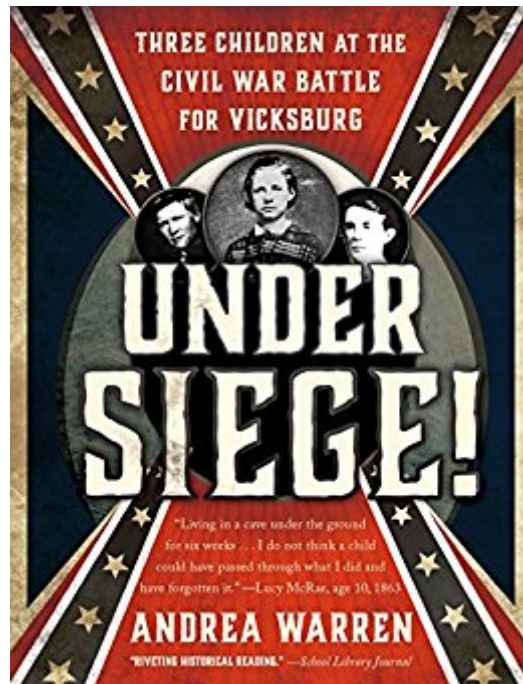

In 1863, Union troops intend to silence the cannons guarding the Mississippi River at Vicksburg — even if they have to take the city by siege. To hasten surrender, they are shelling Vicksburg night and day. Terrified townspeople, including Lucy and Willie, take shelter in caves — enduring heat, snakes, and near suffocation. On the Union side, twelve-year-old Frederick Grant has come to visit his father, General Ulysses S. Grant, only to find himself in the midst of battle, experiencing firsthand the horrors of war. It was a required reading from school. My daughter said it's so boring and complicated.

Our spring vacation trip (March 2011) took us east from our home in Texas: we toured plantations in Natchitoches, Louisiana; antebellum homes in Natchez, Mississippi; and finally the national battleground in Vicksburg. I started preparing for the trip to Vicksburg shortly after Christmas by reading a couple excellent accounts of the campaign. I bought Under Siege! initially for my fifteen-year old daughter, and she did indeed like it very much. My wife, daughter and I took turns reading the book aloud at home and passing it around to share the excellent pictures and maps. We finished reading it on the drive from Dallas to Vicksburg. Although I got it for my daughter initially, I have to say that my wife and I both enjoyed it and learned a lot from it too, and I found it to be an excellent complement to the more objective military history I was reading.

Very well written and told in a narrative that is captivating and keeps you wanting more. I wanted a book that told about the siege of Vicksburg in simple terms for a short presentation. This fit the bill, but I can't wait to give it to my grandson when he is older, since my g-g-g grandfather fought in the Civil War and was one of those Confederates captured and paroled at Vicksburg.
