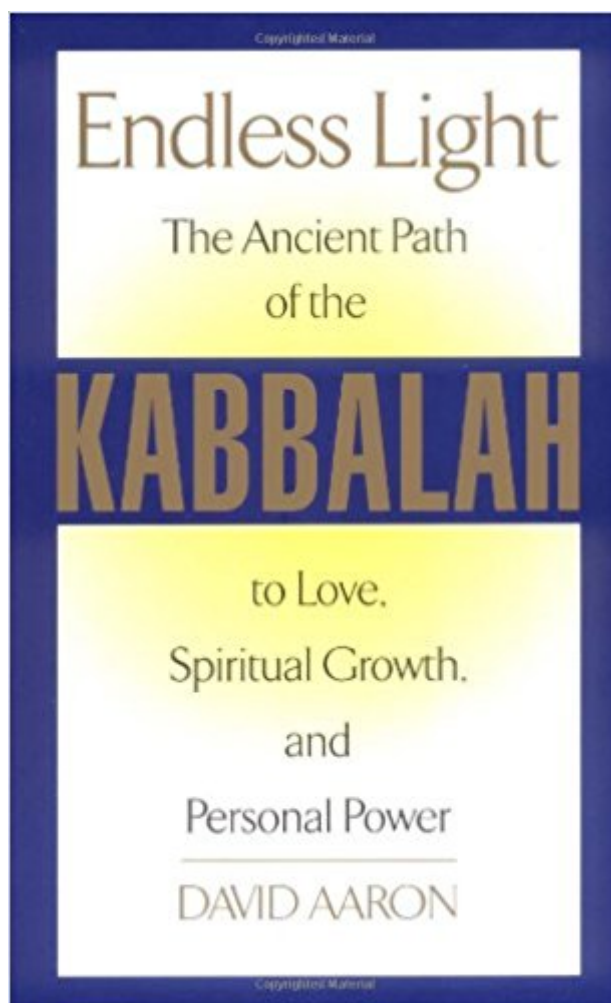


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Endless Light: The Ancient Path Of Kabbalah

In the kabbalah, the creation of the universe is an ongoing process; thus, Aaron says, we derive happiness from the journey to our goals rather than from reaching our destination. Rabbi Aaron teaches in such a way that you feel he is speaking directly to you, right through the pages, as if you were there in the living room with him.
