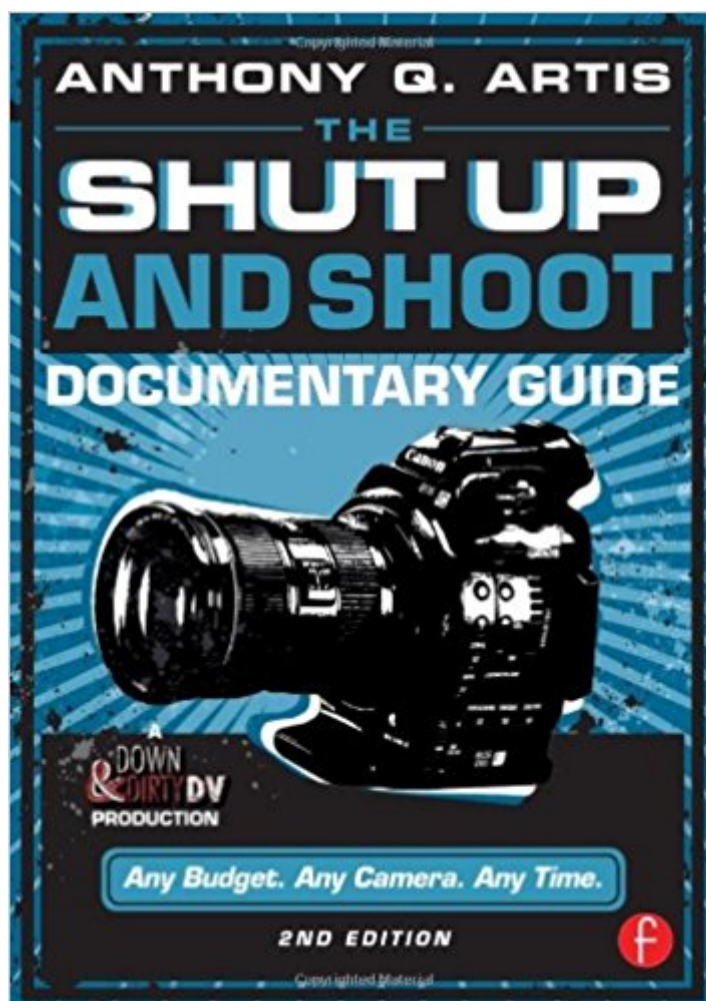

Anthony Q. Artis is a 20-year veteran of the film and TV industry whose features and TV shows have screened at the Tribeca Film Festival, the IFFM Market, Slamdance, and Cinequest, as well as on MTV and the Independent Film Channel. He has worked professionally in positions as diverse as producer, gaffer, and cinematographer, and survived more low-budget shoots than he cares to admit. He remains an active filmmaker, Adjunct Professor of film and TV at NYU and is the author of the bestselling Shut Up and Shoot Documentary Guide (2007), The Shut Up and Shoot Freelance Video Guide (2010) and numerous filmmaking courses on Lynda.com.

This book was one of the greatest investments I've made and I consider it my "go to" guide to keep me motivated with my creative projects. This is not a book filled with theoretical perspectives on filmmaking. Instead, it reads like a recipe book explaining the nuts and bolts of how to do the work. It spans from laying down pre production steps, nailing your concept, writing, composing shots for effect, the importance of sound, what microphones to use, how to conduct interviews, how to watch your six while shooting, troubleshooting potential set problems, the legalities of choosing filming locations, post production and so much more. From start to finish, the book reads like Mr. Artis is your mentor as he candidly, thoroughly explains the specifics of filmmaking as if you're sitting next to him on a bench at a Manhattan subway station. One of the biggest bonuses of reading this book includes his sprinkles of humor and encouragement throughout geared to the budding and brand new artists. He encourages readers to not simply focus on "bigger equipment and bigger budgets" and pulls from his vast experience in the industry when he was just

starting out with a lot of passion, real skills and an anemic set of resources. "If you've got the money, you can get more professional equipment and crew, but if you've got a down and dirty (creative) mindset, you can get more professional results from any equipment or crew," he wrote. He also notes his book is designed to "empower readers to overcome the obstacles of filmmaking to successfully execute their vision." If you want a refreshing book that's supportive of your passion and creative ideas, that's easy to read and understand and breaks down the technical aspects of production like apples and oranges, you'll love this book!

I had to buy this book for a class, but what sets this textbook apart from other textbooks is that it is written in an informal style. The author continuously makes small jokes and I laughed a couple of times reading through it: something that rarely happens when studying.

Lots of good information, covering a broad spectrum of topics, in a thick book.
