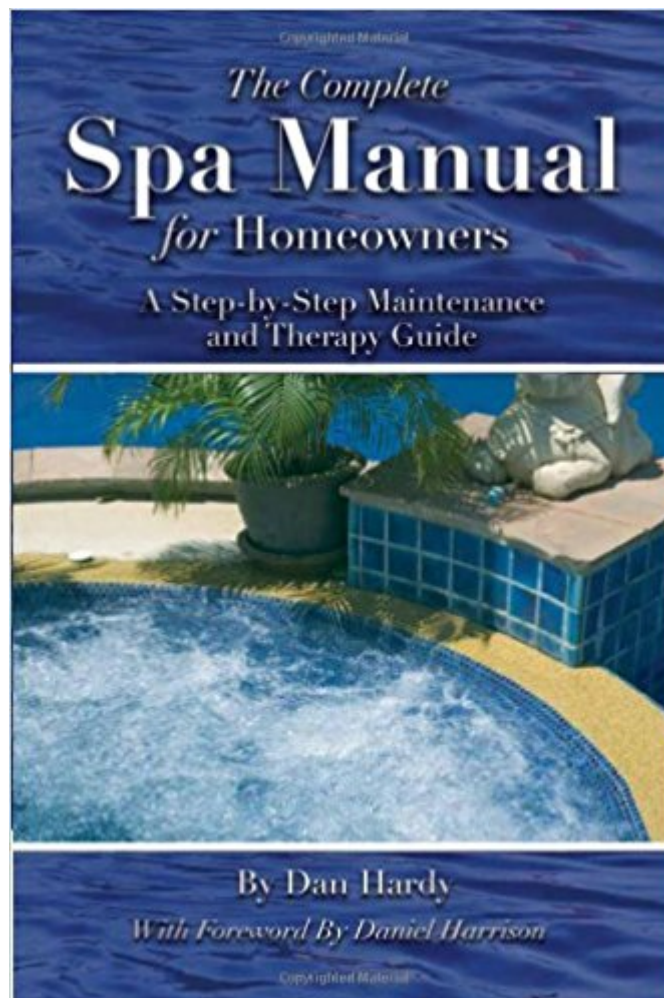

If you are seriously considering the installation of a Spa you should read this book. Not quite what I was looking for. That said, the book talked me out of my project . . . but better to be well informed and a bit disappointed than to spend a lot of money and be disappointed.

I was disappointed in this book, because it did not do a good job of explaining the important aspects of water chemistry maintenance for a spa. It was certainly not a "step by step" guide as suggested in the subtitle. I am an engineer/scientist by training and disposition, so I was interested in learning about the theory and practical application of managing pH, alkalinity (or hardness), sanitizer concentration, etc. but none was presented. I also would have appreciated a procedure-based approach (e.g., first check your pH and adjust, then check and adjust alkalinity, etc.) but that was done in a stream-of-consciousness manner, and spread throughout the text. The reader has take notes and then go construct such procedure from various chapters. I believe a good editor could have made this a much better book. Unfortunately, I have not yet found a better book to recommend over this one.

Spa ownership can be healthy and relaxing, but it can also be costly. A poorly maintained spa means having to hire a third party and pay for parts if you can't do it yourself. The Complete Spa Manual for Homeowners is great for first-time buyers and owners who have fallen behind on the repair front.If you're completely new to spas you can read it from cover to cover and get a good idea of what to look for when buying. You'll get a good idea of the features you need based on your intended use. (You'll have a general idea of standard pricing as well.) If your not interested in reading a spa manual cover to cover, it will still be useful purely as a reference. It's logically structured so you'll be able to find the necessary section quickly, and has a textbook style index in the back so looking things up is a breeze.All in all, it's simple, straightforward, and practical. Everything you need to know about spas and a little more.

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
