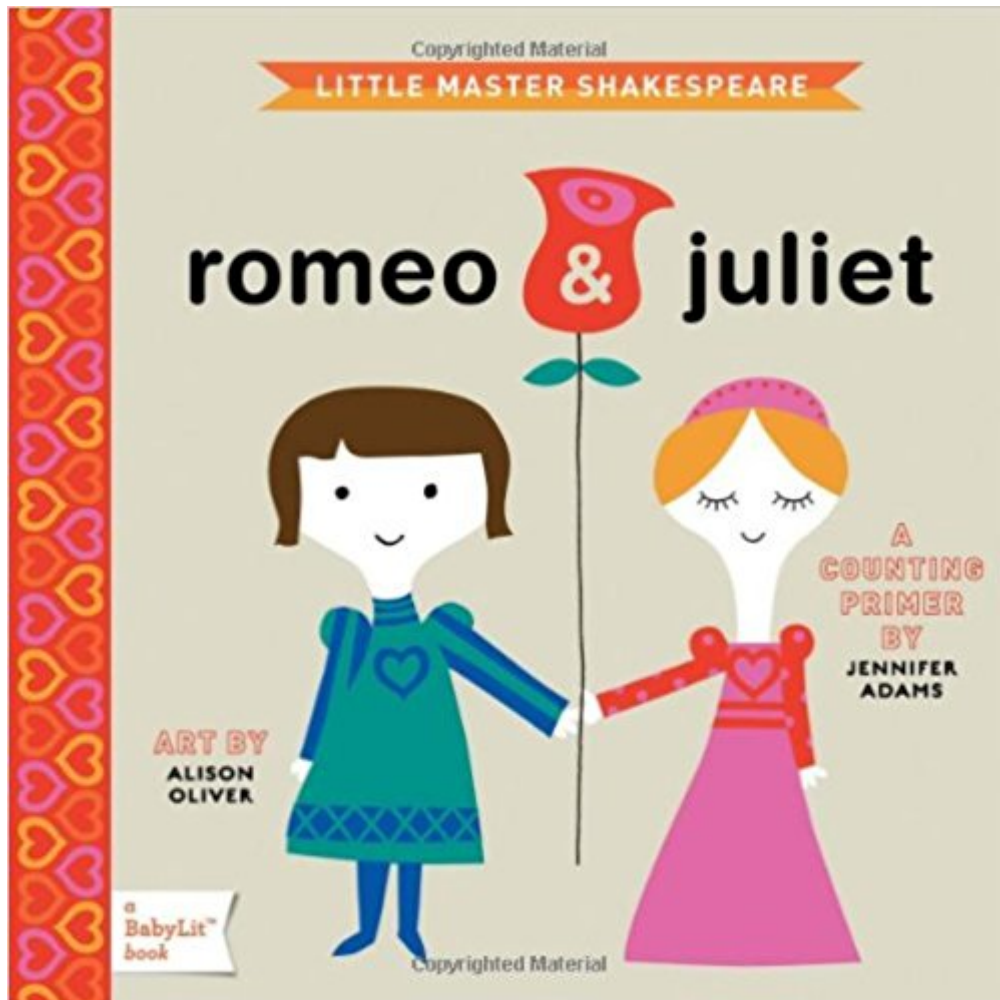

We have ordered just about all of the baby lit books and love to swap them out during seasons and holidays. The artwork and colors are bright and vivid, very pleasant to look at. The mommy and the teacher in me loves and approves these books!

The book itself is very cute, I love it! However, the "new" copies I ordered did not appear to be new at all. There were scuff marks and dents on the front and back covers. I know something is up because I ordered a few of the Midsummer Nights Dream book from the same collection, and those all arrived in great condition. Very disappointed as I'm giving these as a gift to my preschoolers.

Very easy to convey the story.

We bought 5 BabyLit classics and Romeo and Juliet is my son's favorite. He eagerly anticipates the last page where I give him "10 kisses" really fast and sometimes likes skipping to it. The pictures are colorful and he likes touching these more than his touch and feel books.

My 2 year old loves the colors in this book. The "story" is ok, some of the items counted don't make sense and/or aren't exactly how the play goes. My main complaint, as the parent of girls, is that Juliet is drawn with her eyes closed. It bothers me that my daughter thinks the female character is "night night" for the entire book.

Amazing illustrations, and creative way of including aspects from 'Romeo & Juliet' into tangible baby education. This is **not** a baby-abbreviated version of the original story. I highly recommend - just don't order thinking it will be the real 'Romeo & Juliet' baby style ;)
