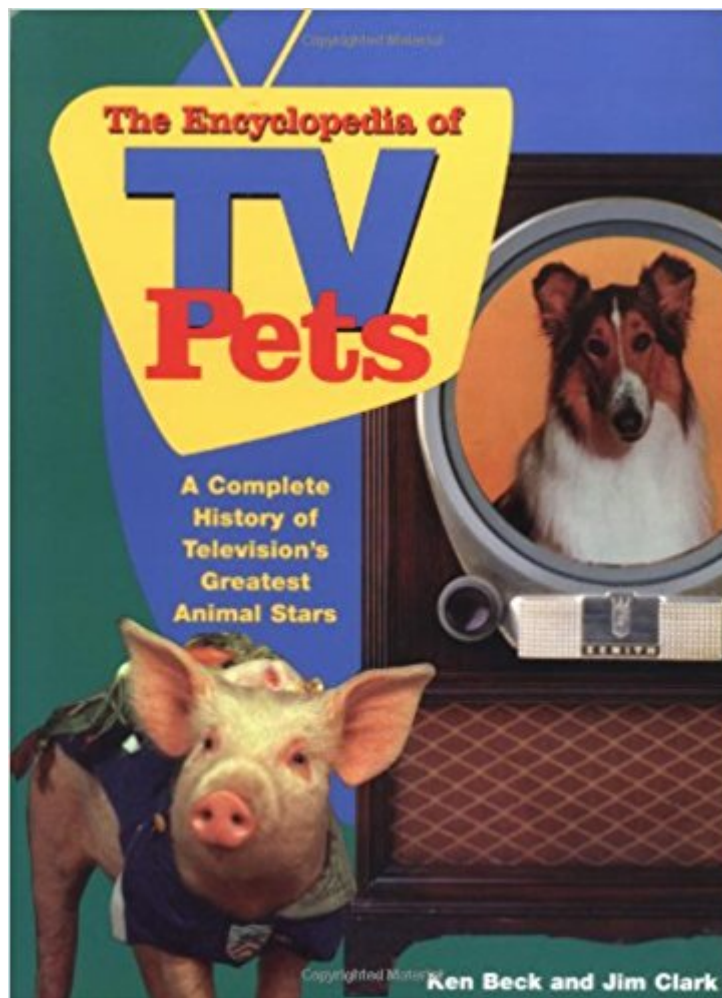




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The Encyclopedia Of TV Pets: A Complete History Of Television's Greatest Animal Stars

Doggone it! Call this one a howling (and oinking, meowing and neighing) success. Here, in one compact book, is the history of the lives and career of TV's greatest stars --- the furry (and usually) four-footed kind. (Who knew the seeing-eye dogs who guided criminal insurance investigator Mike Longstreet were played by three German Shepherds --- Blanco, Snow and Blizzard?) It's a jungle out there. Get ready to grin and bear it. That's "bear" as in "Gentle Ben."
