

Born and raised in Belgium, author Morris moved to the United States in 1946 and stayed six years. There, he worked for MAD magazine and met Rene Goscinny, with whom he collaborated from 1955 until his own death in 1977. Goscinny also created the *Iznogoud* series with illustrator Tabary (published in English by Cinebook) and the hugely successful *Asterix* series with illustrator Uderzo.

Goscinny is one of my most favourite artists who created an array of facial expressions on the major characters perfectly. Some of these Lucky Luke characters are similar to some of these Asterix ones. Likewise, the dumb Daltons are the same with the ignorant Roman soldiers in terms of artistic facial expressions.
