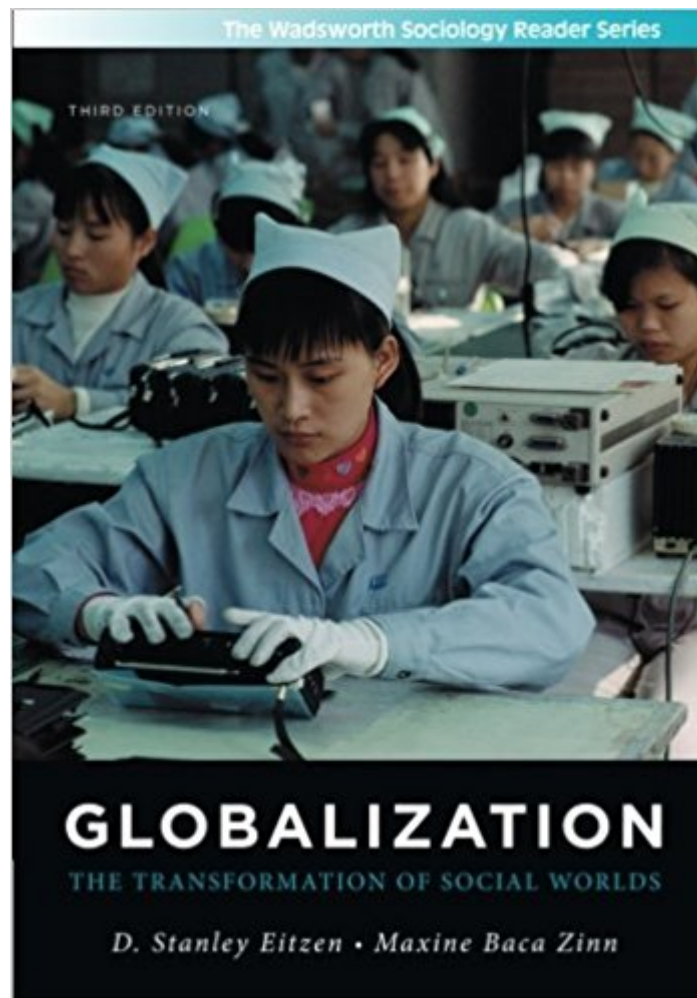


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Globalization: The Transformation Of Social Worlds (Wadsworth Sociology Reader)
