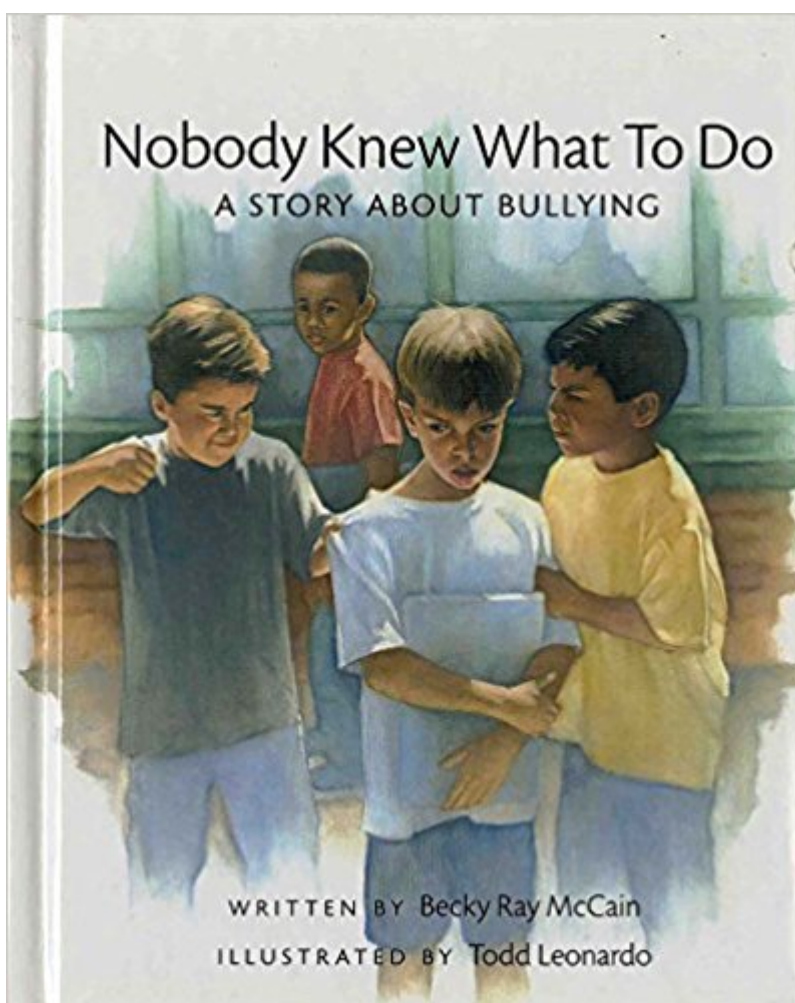

In the world we are faced with so many things that it is easy to over look when a person is hurting. We tend to mask things very well

and it does no good when no one will ask. It is so sad that it goes on and the hurt never really leaves you, I hope that buying this book will allow them to stare clear of situations like this but to be strong enough to speak up when needed.

After reading the reviews, I was anxious to get this book. As a teacher in an inner city school, however, I find it disappointing. It's simplistic view of how easy it is to stop the bully is unrealistic. As someone who deals with this issue every day, I know that simply asking them to tell an adult is not enough.

This book is a quick read and would make a strong impact on students in grades K-3; beyond that grade level, the book is a little simplistic. The contents are great. The author needs to take it a step further and write with grades 4-5; and then 6-8 in mind. A good product and I would recommend it to other teachers as a read aloud to begin a unit on bullying.
