Once again, Shannon fills in the chinks in the story with the most exquisite details, "character development" that gives us more insight into what makes all of our favorite characters what they are, how they tick, and how they will have the courage to fight the battle that looms in their not-too-distant future. Plus, we get just a few little tidbits about what is to come and how this whole story might just play out. Not enough to spoil, but just enough to let us know that she has a plan for finishing the story, and it might not end exactly as you originally thought. We even get to meet a few new characters, most notably a snow leopard named Peta (I can't tell if the acronym-as-name is intentional or not, I may have to re-read to figure that out). The story is exactly what a .5 should be; an interlude, an intermission in the actual storyline, a short story that is as much a part of the storyline as it is not. A side-story. I wouldn't call it a back-story, but I think side-story is a good name for it. All in all, a very engaging (albeit brief) interlude.

In this short story 8.5, Rylee is hurting, but she is still as sharp as ever. This was a fast paced story of dealing with grief but letting love into your heart at the same time. I'm not going to spoil anything, so let's just say, I look SO forward to the next book, Waking Darkness. Here's a summary of this teaser featuring my favorite character: Rylee, after some intense preparations will be ready and rested to take on the Destroyer. She has to heal. She has to morn. This is a must read, if you are reading the series. It is not a side story or an interlude while you wait for the continuation of the saga.I normally read much more intense and deeper fantasy novels, but this is a great read. sci-fi for over 55 years. Mayer builds characters you just have to feel with, they are people that draw you into their story, even (most) of the bad guys. Some of them are not in this book, but it looks like they will all come together in the next one, which by 's note, will be out in April of 2015, which I have already pre ordered..it would be pointless to talk about the people. If you are into the series, you have already read 7 books. If not, DO NOT Read this, go to book one. It is a wild ride worth taking. Download them all onto your Kindle and go to the beach for a week.

Rylee is often crass, prickly, vulgar and a pistol. She fights for the underdog and those she loves. In this novella Rylee leaves behind those she loves to heal herself and bear her child and grieve for the death of her love, Liam. In the process she matures and learns love is the strongest power of all. Several old and a few new characters surround Rylee. All know she must ultimately fight the demon Orion to save the world and her loved ones. No fate is certain yet she goes forward toward whatever fate has in store. An excellent transition from the battles of the previous books. Always a fascinating read in this world of magic and demons and betrayal and loyalty. Great characters to hate and to care about.

I've read 1-9 including all the shorts and this is one of the few series that I've re-read, and will re-read again; one of the few that I'm taking the time to leave a review for. The character development and interactions are superb, as is the world development. Not only are the main characters well done, but all the secondary characters are amazing.
