

I just finished reading the entire four book series, On The Road. This was simply an incredibly written story - and it was definitely too fantastic to fit in one book. Without a doubt, the first and fourth books are the best, but taken in its entirety, the series is soooo much more than simply the sum of its parts. I have read much of Karin Bishop's work over the past several months, but this series must be her crowning achievement. If you only read one story, it should be the story encompassed in these four books. The story follows the life of one young man, beginning right around the time of his nineteenth birthday, when he discovers that rather than a small, delicate young man (a young man who grew up alone, with just his single, ex-hippy mother and his two only friends, a brother and sister) who filled his lonely life with his guitar, that he is instead an incredibly

talented young woman. The story follows her life as she becomes that young woman, growing into a beautiful and multi-talented lady. It follows her through several years as she matures and grows, she makes new friends, finds new family, and discovers ever greater talents. This story stirred depths of emotion and feeling which I did not know I had. The love that Suzee finds in her friends and family, and the joy she finds in her music and her art took me to incredible highs. The pain that she felt due to the loss of friends, the shame and hurt she knows due to the trials and issues as she becomes herself and grows through her life from the lonely Stuart, through Suzee and Destiny, to become Suzanne brought tears to my eyes repeatedly. I found myself smiling with joy, and bawling with hurt. The relationship which Suzee has with her mother, the real, true friends that she finds and develops, these things I wish I had in my life. As I read the interaction between Suzee and her mother, between Suzee and Tina, between Suzee and her friends Erika and Bonnie, my heart ached for what they have. To know the love and joy which they shared. The scenes between Suzee and Earl left me drained, with tears rolling down my face. To have that connection - to have found that person who knows your soul and understands your feelings and loves, and then to lose that person without being able to say goodbye..... My heart was broken, crushed by what she had written. Karin Bishop has written a masterpiece in this story. These four books tell an incredible and incredibly moving tale. If you only read one story in your life, this would be an excellent choice.

This book (and its earlier volumes) is a two level tour de force. The back story is an interesting in depth look at the world of traveling rock bands, with multiple well defined and interesting characters. However, the main story is the continuing growth and development of Suzie (or Suzanne Weston). This transition is far more than a caterpillar to butterfly growth cycle; it's more like a caterpillar to eagle transition. Along the route from Suzie to Suzanne, the heroine impacts and changes many other lives, primarily for the good. I enjoyed the writing and the development of a very interesting character. This was one of the first books I put on my Kindle Fire, and I'm very glad that I bought it.
