

Capstone Press publishes numerous graphic novels (Graphic Library) on numerous subject topics. I have just finished reading this 32 page hardcover (Lords of the Sea: The Vikings explore the North Atlantic by Allison Lassieur, Illustrated by Ron Frenz and Charles Barnett 111) graphic novel and found it to be informative and a fun read. This short volume is organized into four chapters. Chapter one covers the Viking spirit of adventure and relates a brief history of why they decided to raid and conquer other lands. The second chapter deals with their exploration of the

â„¢s further exploration. The third chapter is about the Vikings discover North America. The final chapter focuses on the last Vikings in North America. There is also information about other research sources on the Vikings, a glossary, internet sights and a bibliography. Even though these short graphic novels are obviously for young readers; nevertheless, they do provide very short and basic history of the Vikings. The illustrations also make the story come alive. This book is very basic. It is a graphic format (comic book) that is easy to read and has pretty good illustrations. Judging from the illustrations, Vikings liked to make fists in the air. Hmmm. If you are interested in Viking invasions and explorations, this is a good one. It is simple -- good for young readers. A better book for early grades is "What a Viking!" by Mick Manning -- the information is more complete.

This is an interesting graphic history of the Vikings' discovery of America. I think that this book contains more details about the Vikings' discovery than most childrens books and is very interesting. The graphic history format is great for reading comprehension.
