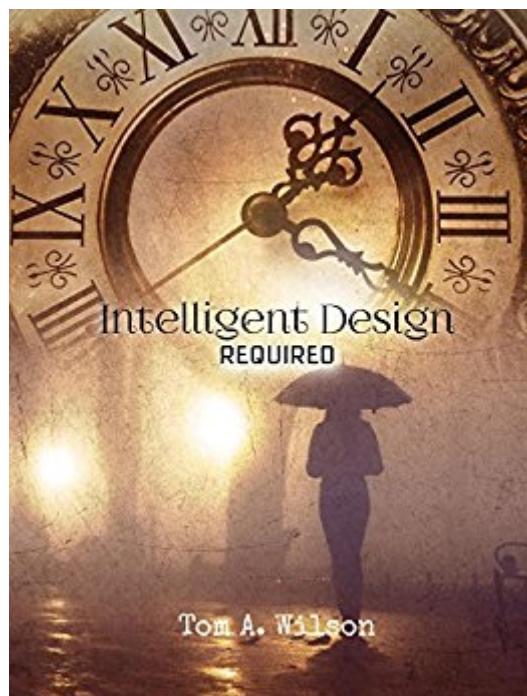

After getting used to the flood of questions that I assume were meant to drive home the points the Author was making, I found myself engrossed in the stimulation it brought to my thinking. A comprehensive evaluation of 2 sides of a controversial coin, this book leaves no stone unturned. For those who want or need to evaluate creation, and consciousness, as they may relate to after death phenomena, Wilson compares random construction with intelligent design through a series of

questions. May get a little dry for some who already believe, but offers in depth, thought provoking arguments. A good read for metaphysical studies. I give it 5 stars.

I don't suppose any argument on either side will ever get me off my agnostic fence, but love reading about it. I have always thought atheism is a faith because I knew you had to have faith in order to believe nothing was there. We agnostics don't have that luxury. Good logical arguments. I do recommend the book. Well thought out if a bit redundant in places, but the author is just hammering it home.

Another well thought out and presented work from Tom Wilson. Once again, he clearly makes the argument that all that has come to be had "Intelligent Design" as the source. No clear minded teachable person could reach any other conclusion. The Author doesn't need to be right in his view and certainly isn't attempting to sell it nor convert the reader to any religion. Actually, the book isn't about religion at all. It's about common sense!

A book that argues against atheism in many ways. This is also not a religious book by any means but one that fully supports the belief that there is a creator (or as he says intelligent designer). The author asks the reader questions to stimulate the thought process, which can be a little redundant, but strongly drives home his point of view. If you are interested in this subject I recommend this book.

After reading many of the author's works, I am very pleased with his latest addition. If you, (like many others) have been questioning the possibility of an intelligent designer, your search is over. Just open the book, you won't put it down.

I have become a fan of Tom Wilson (I have read his books, "God Life After Death" and "God & The Afterlife Proven"). He continues to do a masterful job writing in a persuasive manner, and is articulate, logical, and writes in a manner that is easily understood and is no small feat for such a deep subject. A winning combination for this author or any author. Personally, I believe that "nature" alone provides enough evidence of Intelligent Design (God) but to reduce the answer to the

question to its basic element requires an understanding of the human nature. Every individual that has ever lived or will live has focused or will focus in on "I" or "me." This is a natural consequence of our existence and perception of our circumstances and of the world around us. Therefore, everyone develops their own presuppositions as to how they "fit" and can accept the world around them thereby being lulled into fulfilling their presuppositions without regard to the reality around them. Either way there is always an element of faith in those presuppositions. Unless something punctures this presuppositional layer of perception then assessment of one's reality doesn't occur and change of perception doesn't happen. The key is to look at evidence without regard to one's presuppositions in order to weigh the evidence as objectively as possible (Again, there will always be an element of faith no matter which side of the spectrum one may fall). The individual must temporarily set aside any preconceived notions in order to fairly evaluate what it is that they are perceiving. Individual perception changes only the perception of truth. Truth is truth, but every individual responds as to how they perceive the truth. We are all "sieves" in that we allow in only what reconciles to our perceptions. Sometimes rightly so but other times not so rightly. Tom states, "The fact is, the proof is there, right in front of you when you look at it and interpret in the correct way. Focus on improving your interpretation as it is more important than the object that you see."
