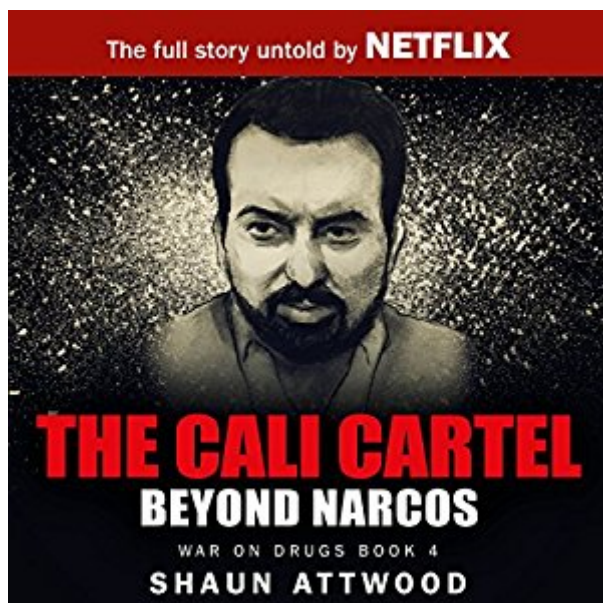


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The Cali Cartel: Beyond Narcos

Another of Attwood's books that I read in one sitting! Attwood does a great job of describing the Cali cartel, who are the focus of Narcos seasons three and four. Unlike Pablo Escobar, not much has been written about the Cali cartel, and Attwood brings everything up-to-date with a fast-paced story that had me hooked from beginning to end. At the same time you get a good look at the messed up war on drugs and a really thought provoking view of how America could have actually been a lot more involved than the government wants you to think. This book actually taught me a lot of information I didn't know about Colombian traffickers, the government, Los Pepes and the DEA. I'm happy to give this book 10/10! This latest instalment in Shaun Attwood's War on Drugs series makes powerful reading. Building on his riveting analysis of the career of Colombian drugs baron, Pablo Escobar, Attwood now shifts his emphasis on to the rival group - the Cali cartel. Running their criminal empire like a business syndicate, the four Cali 'godfathers' established a multi-billion dollar narcotics enterprise and, after Escobar's death, became the key players in Colombian cocaine trafficking. This book is packed with information, stark truths and new insights. Attwood knows his material inside-out and presents a clear, incisive analysis of the political situation, the personalities involved and the shifting relationships between the rival factions. It is fast-paced and extremely readable and will leave you with a much deeper understanding of the issues and the negative consequences of drugs prohibition.
