

I am not what you would call a reader, never have been. My attention span would not cross a small stream. But, I stumbled on this book *Timeless Moments* by Michelle Kidd and thought why not give it a look. Not only did this book amaze me, I also amazed myself. I read the entire thing. I had no choice, it grabbed a hold of me and wouldn't let go. I expected some sappy love story with every cliché storyline one could imagine, but what I found was a new and mysterious world for me to step into and explore. I don't know what was

better, the characters or the setting I found myself following them around in and it doesn't matter. This is not your typical love, time travel, try to stay awake story. Michelle expertly crafts each scene so that the reader feels they are standing right there in the living room, feeling the warmth from the fireplace. The dialogue fits each character perfectly giving the sense that you are listening instead of reading. Her characters are so lifelike and believable you will end up feeling as if you have known them all of your life. Time travel is a little far fetched I'll admit but I am a believer now and you would be to if you read this wonderful enchanting tale. How this author brought this all together is beyond me. At no point in this book was I able to even come close to guessing the outcome. And when it arrived and made perfect sense, I was blown away. I found myself relating to and happy I had the opportunity to meet these fictional characters, from Jack, Jewel and the evil Hunsdon to Addie and Culpepper and all of the other wonderful characters in this story. Somehow I became friends with all of them, except Hunsdon, I couldn't stand that guy. And the main character, in my opinion, that grand old wonderful house with its wooden floors and creaky staircase and that window seat, yes, that window seat. This book has it all and I can honestly say, if it could hook and hold me, it will appeal to anyone. I am not what you would have called a reader, but I am now. I highly recommend *Timeless Moments* by Michelle Kidd. This is one book that should be in everyone's personal library.

This is one of the best books I've read in the past few years - and I read a LOT. I was pleasantly surprised by how this story grabbed me and pulled me into different worlds. The author deftly handles dimensional shifts between time and her character development is absolutely spot-on. I despised Hunsdon, rooted for Jack and Jewel, and found myself in the old South with Addie and Culpepper. And the old house that Jack is refurbishing...well, I was right there with him. The writing is so descriptive that I watched it all unfold like a movie. The plot twists kept me engaged and guessing. This is one of those novels that you can't wait to get home from work (or shopping or whatever), so you can get back to the story to find out what happens next. And the ending is superb. Very highly recommended! This is an author to watch!

I have not finished the book yet, but I started reading at 10 PM and read 10 chapters before falling asleep. The next morning I read another 6 chapters in the time it takes my kids to get ready for school. The story really sucks you in at the first paragraph. At one point it changes to first person so be ready for that. But you soon will not pay attention to the fact that it is third person and your mind

will start to wondering, "is it a person we have already met? Did they really time travel?" I LOVE the fact that it is set in Historic Lynchburg, VA. It makes me want to look up these people and see if they are real or if she just made them up. They seem so real. Oh, and I LOVE the local plugs in the book. If you LOVE the book like I have so far, you will want to see some of the places she mentions and Lynchburg would love to have you explore Rivermont Ave, and other places mentioned in the book.

It's 2014, and Jack Vine has just moved into an old house in Lynchburg, VA, a house that he's always coveted. One morning, he spots a young woman crying in his garden. When he confronts her, she accuses him of being an invader in her house, dashes inside, and disappears. In 1917, Jewel Wiltshire is trapped in marriage to an abusive, controlling husband. She begins to fear for her life, and after she finds that she's pregnant, she decides to run away, which puts her on a collision course with her murderous husband. Alone in her garden one morning, she is confronted by a strange young man who claims that he lives in her house, and then he disappears. There then begins a strange communication between Jack and Jewel across time, which brings endangers not only Jewel's life, but the lives of her unborn child and her devoted servants. *Timeless Moments* by Michelle L. Kidd is a first novel that was selected for publication in the Kindle Scout program. The author does a fantastic job of weaving not just two, but three time streams together in a mystery that will capture the reader's interest from page one and hold it until the stunning finale. Kidd is a storyteller who shows a lot of promise for the future.

I decided to read this story because it was about time travel. To my surprise it was so much more, mystery, suspense, beloved characters, hated characters, a twisting plot and much read. It is my favorite book in a long time. It is hard to put down.
