

If you have ever struggled with the age old issue of the Sovereignty of God and the responsibility of man, this short, well worded work is one of the most concise, readable works you will be able to find. It's one of those books I have read more than once and continues to be a resource for me.

Many wonder how evangelism plays into the biblical truth of God's sovereignty. This book answers that question well. One will likely be equipped to understand these truths better after reading it.

I read this book as a text for a seminary class in an MDiv program. I found it to be very helpful in shaping the balance of Calvinist sovereignty of God and Arminian responsibility of man doctrines. Evangelism is important of course, and efforts need to be made to reach the lost. However our efforts are merely a mechanism by which God reaches the lost and we need not see our evangelism efforts as a success or failure to get people to make commitments. We must simply speak the truth lovingly and boldly, what those who hear it do with it is not up to us.

If you've wrestled with the topics of the sovereignty of God versus your responsibility to share the gospel, this book was written for you.

This is a great book for anyone who agrees it is GOD who chooses, but then has trouble wondering why we, as Christians, are supposed to share the good news with others.
