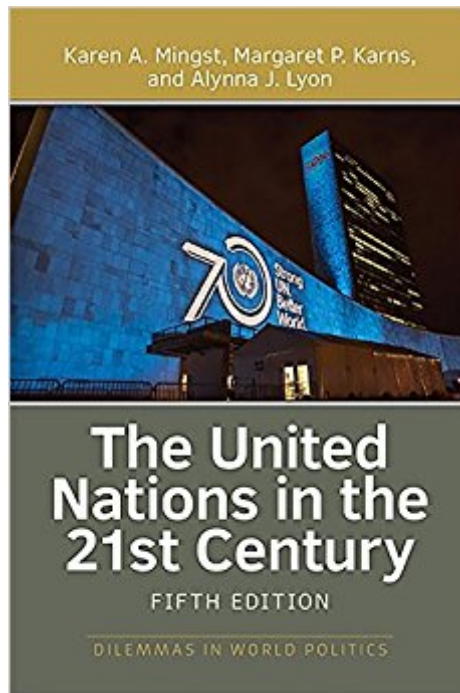


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The United Nations In The 21st Century (Dilemmas In World Politics)
