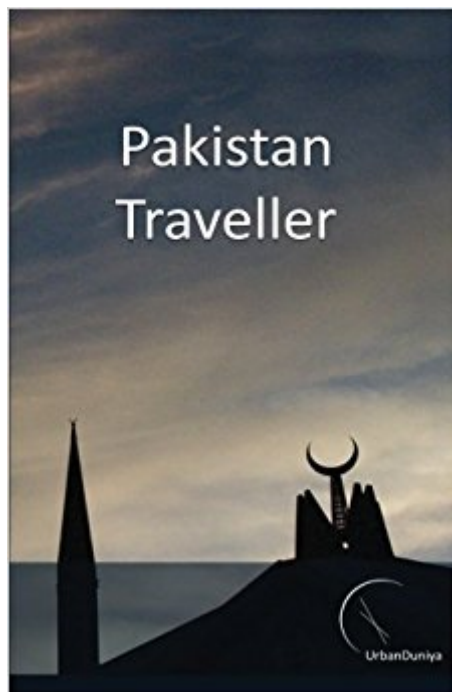

Wonderful. Well-written, comprehensive guide to Pakistan. It's just like a Lonely Planet, but up-to-date (2015), since Lonely Planet hasn't published its Pakistan guide since 2008. Just like LP, it has sections on each region, city, and sight -- suggested itineraries, seasons to go, how to get there and away, history, places to stay (from backpacker to luxury), places to eat, places to shop, police/emergency info, maps. My only gripe is that the internal links in the Kindle version, e.g., in the Table of Contents, don't work properly on my computer. But the book certainly still earns five stars, especially given how little tourist info is available on Pakistan these days.

This was the only book about Pakistan that I could find that had some great descriptions and useful insights! If you're vacationing in Pakistan - this is the book you want!
