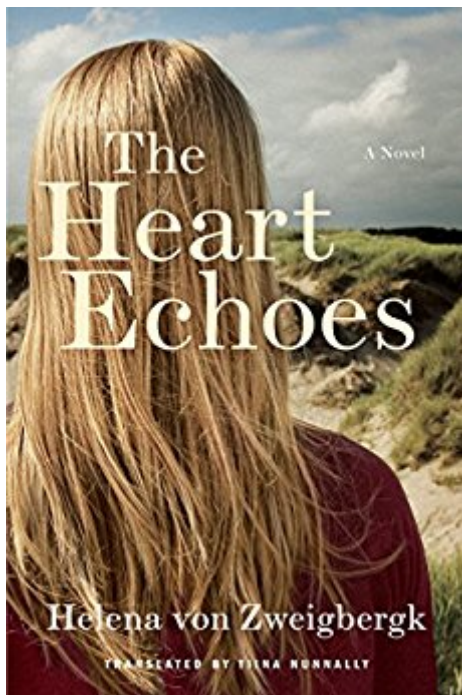


The book was found

I like Swedish writers and settings so this was an easy Kindle First choice, but it also turned out to be a little gem. This was good family drama with fairly well-developed characters, and the resolutions felt real, if a little sad. The only part of the book that fell flat, for me, was one of the sisters' love interest with another woman -- the characters and the storyline seemed shallow at best. I can't say it was gratuitous since I don't know the author's intent there, but the same-sex relationship wasn't really necessary to the story and I would have enjoyed it more without it. Overall a good weekend read.

This book was a story of three sisters and their loves and losses. Life is good for them but it is also a struggle for them. Then there is the fact that there are secrets that causes friction between them. The death of one of them brings them to gather in a new understanding of life. I would give the book 4 Stars.

The continued use of present tense increases the immediacy of the reading experience.
