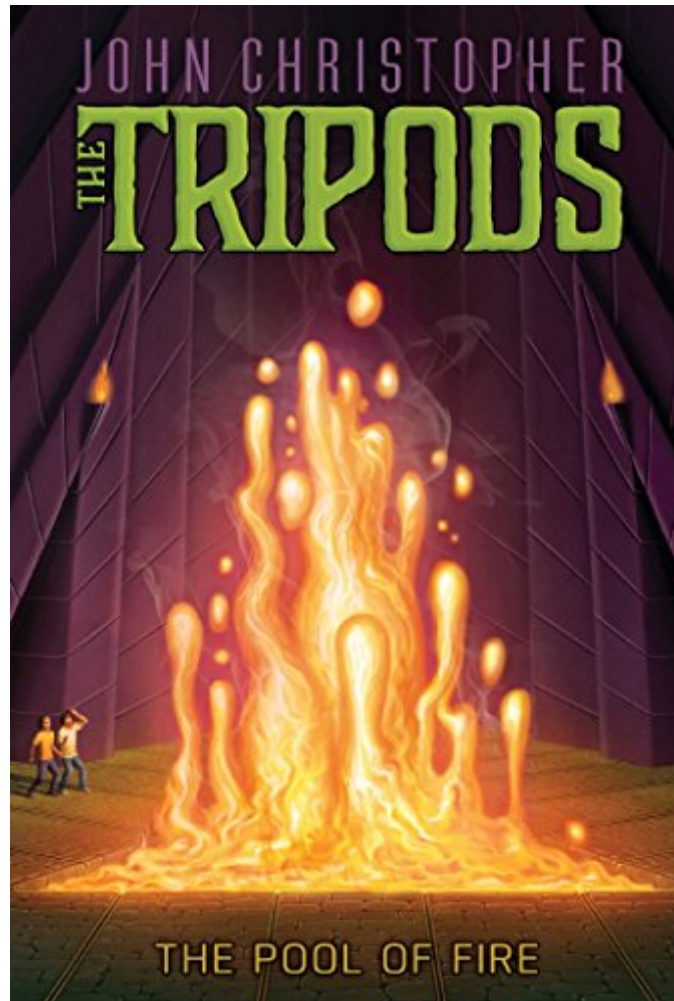

I thought this book was ok; not as good as previous two installments... The main complaint is that there wasn't a great deal of buildup or suspense, it all seemed too easy. The main climax comes about halfway through and then there is a fairly long falling action that finishes things off, and has its

moments, but still feels like an afterthought. Then the denouement is realistic I suppose but not very satisfying. It's hard to get more specific without giving away details of the story. Overall I feel like the author was at his best in "The White Mountains" where there was a sense of journey and adventure, and a sense of mystery and unknown about the Tripods. "City of Gold and Lead" lifts the veil on the mystery and is very imaginative and atmospheric. In this book, the mystery is already revealed, and rather than a journey, it's just about getting a job done. Also I found our protagonist more annoying this time around, like everyone else is growing up around him and he's still a bit insufferable

I was happy that men had defeated the Masters. In the end I was sad to see the same old arguments that man has with people from other countries. We all need to get along with each other. In the end I was happy to find that Will, Fritz, and Beanpole would work for the betterment of the human race.
