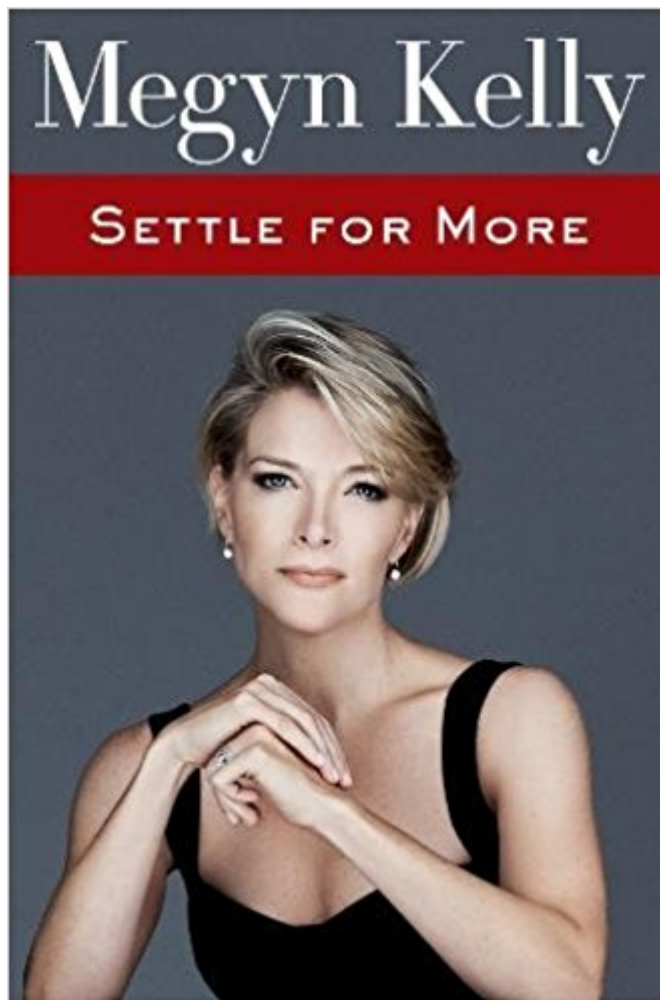

Prior to her career in television news, Kelly practiced law for nine years, seven years as a corporate litigator at Jones Day and was an associate for two years in the Chicago office of the law firm Bickel & Brewer LLP. She lives in New York with her husband and children.

Megyn Kelly is a terrific news anchor, a smart, aggressive and witty commentator, a bright and beautiful woman, apparently a dutiful and loyal daughter and a great mom and wife, she is not however, a writer. I very much wanted to like this book because I like Ms. Kelly but, unfortunately the writing is pedestrian. Her narrative could have been much more enchanting, far more colorful and interesting had she opted for fewer first person pronouns and elaborated more on the things around her that both set a stage on which her life played out and influenced her decisions and direction. The writing is flat and lifeless, unlike Ms. Kelly's personality as projected on the small screen. This is what ghost writers are for and Megyn's book could have been so much more with the aid of a skilled wordsmith.

Megyn is a professional and remarkable woman with an inspirational life story, from her childhood and family to law and then journalistic careers.
